



Code of Conduct

1. Behaviour

The London Knights expect all members, guardians of members, and spectators to maintain the highest standards when representing the club at all events. This includes non-club events where individuals can be recognised as a part of the organisation.

- On Court:
 - a. Know and respect the rules.
 - b. Show respect to teammates, opponents, officials, coaches, and members of the public.
 - c. Never argue with a referee decision even if you disagree.
 - d. Win, lose, or draw with dignity and shake hands with opposition after each match.
 - e. Play honestly to the best of your ability and encourage others to do so as well.
 - f. Play safely and in line with the Health & Safety Policy.
 - g. Support teammates to help them improve.
 - h. Promote fair and equal play.
- Community Engagement:
 - a. Club members are encouraged to share their positive experience with the community through social media, word of mouth, and distribution of other promotional materials.
 - i. Negative experiences should be raised by completing an incident report form and should never be shared until after any investigation has been completed as this can impede on the integrity of the investigation.
 - b. Members should act respectfully when attending on events on behalf of the London Knights and must abide by the organisers rules and regulations.

2. Confidentiality

- Members must abide by the guidelines set in the Data Security Policy.
- Members should not attempt to obtain information they are not privy to.
- Members must keep club tactics within the club only. Tactics should never be shared with anyone outside the club, even after the player has left.

3. Welfare

- Members must abide by all club policies including but not limited to Safeguarding, Equality & Diversity, and Health & Safety. Copies of all policies are available on our website.

Members are advised that most London Knights's activities are in line with British Dodgeball's rules and regulation. Members should familiarise themselves with these policies and abide by them at any British Dodgeball events.
